


## St. Petersburg Yacht Club 2018 St. Petersburg - Habana Race

February 24 - March 03, 2018


## Cuba libre!







- First Race March 30, 1930 finished in the lee of Morro Castle at the Habana harbor entrance.
- 11 boat fleet and was won by the elegant schooner Haligonian owned by Houston Wall of Tampa.

1960 Ban on US Travel and other sanctions

2015 Reestablished some relations, but still illegal to do business








# What's it like to race on blue water?

- Started with Schooners in early 1930s.
- Race suspended 1967-2017
- Revived 2017, 80 boats started, 22 finished (in 2017)

## Blue Heron History & Tactics

- Designed by Gerry Douglas, Russ had weekly "tweaking" meetings
- 1.5 years old
- 3,484 miles to date
- Roller 150 genoa, in mast rolling main
- Heavy Emphasis on weather predictions
- "Long distance races won or lost at night" Russ
- Shifts: two shift split, 6 hour days, 2x3hr night shifts
- Trim, trim, trim....




